# 905

The 905 bus route was launched by Stagecoach in August 2020, replacing route x5 between Bedford and Cambridge.

To provide a quick journey, buses only stop at the following stops:

## 905 Bedford to Cambridge:

**Bedford:** Bus Station (stop O), Dean Street

**Goldington:** Goldington Green, Elms Farm Ind Est

**Great Barford:** The Cross

**Roxton:** Park Road

**Wyboston:** Wyboston Footbridge

**Eaton Socon:** Little End Road, Field Cottage Road

**St Neots:** Market Square (stop E), Longsands Road, Loves Way

**Lower Cambourne:** Woodfield Lane, Apley Way

**Cambourne:** Monkfield Park Primary, De La Warr Way, Business Park

**Cambridge:** Cambridge Regional College, Science Park, Fair Street, Napier Street, Grafton Centre, Parkside (stop 16)

## How frequent is the service?

- The 905 runs every 30 minutes Monday-Sunday.
- Cambridge Science Park and Cambridge Regional College are only served Monday-Friday until 19:00.

## Other service information:

- The route will initially operate within the Science Park on a hail and ride basis until permanent stops can be located. Those wishing to board must clearly indicate this to the driver in a safe place and those wanting to leave the bus must ring the bell in plenty of time.
- A new timetable will operate on the route from Sunday 10th January in order to improve service reliability. Find out more at [stagecoachbus.com](http://stagecoachbus.com)
- Customers travelling on the 905 who wish to continue their journey onwards towards Milton Keynes and Oxford, can buy a transfer ticket which allows them to transfer between the two services without paying twice.
- Double deck buses operate on this route so bikes must be folded, bagged and kept with you at all times.
